Key verse: Galatians 6:9 *"Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."*

God is always preparing us for what He wants from us - future. He's got your name and number and wants you to keep going.

No matter the circumstances or season, Jesus is the One who brings change and fulfilment. We keep sowing seeds in pointing people to Him.

Apple: you can count the number of seeds in an apple but not the number of apples in a seed – and this is why we keep sowing seeds, planting, believing God for great things.

**How do we guard ourselves from growing weary?**

1. We take the time to rest and build up our relationship with Jesus.  
(Watch the gauges; there are times we need to pull aside and fill up again).
2. Remember these things:
  - a. God will cause a harvest to come – we are co-workers; He is in control as Lord of the harvest.
  - b. God is never early or late – we work alongside His plan and purposes
  - c. God never gives up on you – He can take a life and radically transform it
